

Tub/Shower/Whirlpool/Spa Cosmetic Maintenance Guide

Your newly resurfaced/refinished and/or repaired bathing product(s) MUST be maintained in the manner listed below. The following instructions will keep the finish clean and attractive.

Average repair service call fee: \$200.00

1. DO NOT wipe down/clean the product(s) surface(s) with any type of cleaning chemicals for twenty-four (24) hours following resurfacing/refinishing/repair completion.
2. DO NOT allow the room where resurfacing/refinishing/repair has been completed to fall below room temperature(s) for twelve (12) hours following completion.
3. For complete resurfaced/refinished product(s), DO NOT replace/re-install plumbing fixtures for twenty-four (24) hours following completion.
4. Regular cleaning is important to prevent dirt/soap scum build-up. Clean with warm water, soft clothes or soft sponge, and liquid detergents only. NEVER use a cleaning agent that withholds "a grit substance" – this type of product(s) will harm the surface.
5. For complete resurfaced/refinished product(s), NEVER use bathmats or any item with suction cups on finish.
6. Repair all leaking/dripping faucets immediately. Constant leaking/dripping will cause premature wear and rust stains within the finish.
7. If using a drain cleaner/opener, pour into the drain using a plastic funnel.
8. It is recommended not to store soap bars, shampoo bottles, bath oil bottles, etc. on the product(s) shelves. Water becomes trapped underneath these items, and in time, will cause premature wear and rust stains within the finish.
9. NEVER allow nail polish remover to come in contact with the product(s) surface.

Additions:

Liquid car wax works well to protect the finish and make it easier to clean your product(s). Apply wax once (1) every six (6) months. NEVER wax the floor of your product(s) – this will make the floor surface slippery and dangerous.
