

## **Whirlpool/Spa System Maintenance Guide**

FAILURE TO PERFORM PERIODIC MAINTENANCE PROCEDURES MAY CAUSE SAFETY AND/OR HEALTH PROBLEMS AND MAY HARM THE THE CIRCULATING SYSTEM AND/OR PUMP, AND WILL VOID THE WARRANTIES.

Circulating System: The whirlpool/spa system must be purged at least monthly if used on a daily basis; the cleaning can be done once every 3 months if used periodically.

1. Fill the whirlpool/spa with hot water (not exceeding 140°F). Add to the hot water, six (6) tablespoons of low foaming detergent such as liquid Cascade or Calgonite and twenty-four (24) ounces of liquid household bleach, such as Clorox.
2. Turn the air controls completely off.
3. Run the whirlpool/spa for ten (10) minutes.
4. Drain the bath completely and refill with cold water only.
5. Run the whirlpool/spa for ten (10) minutes.

The use of certain bath oils, bubble baths, and bath additives may increase the level of accumulation(s) of bath residue in the whirlpool/spa system. More frequent cleaning may be necessary if these products are used in the whirlpool/spa. If excess accumulation(s) persist, you should discontinue use of these products.
